IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING THIS APPLIANCE

When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed.

WARNING: To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury:

- Do not leave appliance when plugged in. Unplug from outlet when not in use and before servicing.
- 2. Do not use outdoors or on wet surfaces.
- Do not allow to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used by or near children.
- 4. Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- 5. Do not use with damaged cord or plug. If appliance is not working, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, return it to a service center.
- Do not pull or carry by cord or use cord as a handle, do not pinch cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners. Do not run appliance over cord. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- 7. Do not unplug by pulling on cord. To unplug, grasp the plug, not the cord.
- 8. Do not handle plug or appliance with wet hands.

- 9. Do not put any object into openings. Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce air flow.
- 10. Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts.
- 11. Turn off all controls before unplugging.
- 12. Use extra care when cleaning on stairs.
- 13. Do not use **near** flammable or combustible liquids, such as gasoline, or use in areas where they may be present.
- 14. Use only tap water to refill the boiler and water tank. Do not use chemicals, perfumes or other liquid.
- 15. The hose contains electrical wires. Do not use when damaged, cut, or punctured. Avoid sharp objects.
- 16. Connect to a properly grounded outlet only. See Grounding Instructions.
- 17. This appliance is provided with double insulation. Use only identical replacement parts.
- 18. **DO NOT** use a flammable or combustible liquid to clean a floor.



GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS

This appliance must be electrically grounded. If it should malfunction or breakdown, grounding provides a path of least resistance for electric current to reduce the risk of electric shock. This appliance is equipped with a cord withgrounding conductor and a grounding plug. The plug must be inserted into an appropriate outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.

WARNING – Improper connection of the grounding conductor can result in a risk of electric shock. Check with a qualified electrician or service person if you are in doubt as to whether the outlet is properly grounded. Do not modify the plug provided with the appliance – if it will not fit the outlet, have a proper outlet installed by a qualified electrician.

This appliance is for use on a circuit having a nominal rating more than 120 volts and is factory-equipped with a specific electric cord and plug to permit connection to a proper electric circuit. It consists of a boiler fitted with an electrical heater which heats water and produces steam. Using the accessories supplied and the controls and adjustment devices of the machine, steam can be directed towards the surface to be cleaned.

GENERAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Thoroughly read and understand these instructions before turning on the machine.
- Do not connect the machine to the power source with wet or damp hands or in the vicinity of wet surfaces or water.
- Never submerge the machine into water or other liquids.
- Do not shift or move the machine by pulling its power cord, hose or accessories.
- Do not leave the machine on raised surfaces.
- Before connecting the machine to the power source, make sure the power cord is not defective or damaged.
- During use, make sure the power cord does not come in contact with hot, sharp or abrasive surfaces to avoid damage to its protective sheathing.
- Do not allow children to play with the machine and do not use it for purposes other than those specified in paragraph "Use of the machine".
- If the power cord is not long enough, use approved extensions. If you buy coiled extension cables, always unwind them completely before use.

- Do not cover the machine when it is running.
- Do not reduce the steam passage in the tubes with obstructions or kinks in the hose.
- Do not direct steam at appliances with electrical parts.
- Do not direct steam at persons, animals, plants, hot or cold objects, food and food containers.
- Always unplug the machine from the power source before storing it.
- Do not attempt to open, repair or modify the machine or its components.
- Use the filling bottle provided to fill the boiler.
- Always check that the voltage of the power supply match the voltage of the machine.
- Always make sure that the surfaces being cleaned can withstand the temperature given in paragraph

"Technical specifications" without suffering damage. If in doubt, test on a small less visible area.

USE OF THE MACHINE

The machine has been designed and built exclusively to steam-clean/sanitize household surfaces;

Room temperature must be between $+5^{\circ}$ and $+40^{\circ}$.

IMPROPER USE

Any use other than those stated above shall be considered improper.

In particular, it is forbidden to use the machine in areas or places classified as potentially explosive.



ATTENTION

Conformity with the use and maintenance instructions provided by the manufacturer is essential for proper use.

Improper use of the machine voids any warranties, third party liability and may shorten the longevity of the machine.

UNPACKING THE MACHINE

Unpack the machine and make sure it is in in good condition and damage free.

If you are in doubt about anything, do not use the machine and address any concerns with your dealer or the APEX Technical Service Team.

Keep the all of the packaging for returning the machine to the manufacturer should any maintenance or warranty repair be necessary.

STEAM HOSE WITH QUICK-FIT COUPLING

Connecting the hose

This operation is necessary to connect the cleaning accessories to the machine.

- 1) Take the quick-fit coupling 13 at the end of the steam hose and check that the safety catch 14 is turned upwards (fig. 3).
- 2) With the other hand lift up flap 9 and push the quick-fit coupling into its seat.
- 3) Ensure the safety catch 14 is locked

If the catch is not locked, lift up the flap again and push the quick-fit coupling firmly into place.





Disconnecting the hose

- 1) With one hand lift up flap 9 (fig. 4)
- 2) With the other hand seize the quickfit coupling 13 and with your thumb press on the safety catch 14 and pull outwards to remove it.



CAUTION

Do not carry out this operation if you have wet hands. Also check that the protection flap is placed correctly and is not blocked in the open position.

USING THE ACCESSORIES



ATTENTION

Do not carry out the following operations if the accessories have just been used as they may be hot.

ASSEMBLY

Press the spring button 24 and fit the accessory B you wish to use the handle 15 (or extension wand) as shown in fig. 5. Make sure the spring button 24 is firmly in place A.

DISMANTLING

To remove the accessory, hold the spring button 24 pressed and pull out the accessory.

ASSEMBLING AND REMOVING THE SWIVEL JOINT FOR THE BRUSHES

Fit the square brush (21) and the triangle brush (26) to the handle of the flexible hose or the wands following the steps described in the previous chapter.

The square brush (21) has a small lever C which lets you turn the handle as shown in fig. 6:

- lever in locked position ☐: handle locked;





MOUNTING THE CLEANING CLOTHS ON THE BRUSHES

The rectangular brush 21 and the triangular brush 26 (if any) are fitted with a holding device for the attachment of a cleaning cloth.

- 1) Lay a cloth on the ground and set the brush right in the middle.
- 2) Press the upper part of the springfitted cloth holders D to lift them up. With the other hand, position the front and rear edges of the cloth under the holders. Once released, they will hold the cloth in position (fig. 7-8).

To remove the cloth from the brush, press the holders to lift them up.

To use a cloth on the triangular brush 26, proceed as above using the spring-fitted cloth holders (fig. 9).







MOUNTING THE SMALL BRUSHES

To clean small or hard-to-reach surfaces, we recommend using the small brushes 46-47-48-49, attached to the curved steam nozzle 32.

The two reference marks on the brushes and on the steam nozzle must line up, then press the two components one against the other to couple them (fig. 10).

To remove the brushes, grasp and pull them out.

FILLING THE TANK WITH WATER

APX750

ATTENTION

Before filling the water tank, disconnect the machine from the power source.

Before filling the water tank, make sure that:

- 1) plug 10 is unplugged
- 2) the machine is on a flat surface.



CAUTION

Your steam cleaner has been designed for use with normal tap water. In order to extend the life of this product, if the degree of water hardness is very high in your area,

recommend using 50% tap water with 50% distilled water. Do not use other liquid (chemical, fragances, etc...).

Then:

- 1) remove the tank plug 1 by turning it counter-clockwise and pour water up to the max level.
- 2) refit and tighten plug 1.

For this operation, we recommend using the filling bottle 43 provided.

CONNECTION TO THE POWER SOURCE

Before connecting the machine to the power source ensure that:

- the voltage and power ratings of the machine stated on the data plate are compatible with the electrical system.
- the electrical system to which the machine will be plugged complies with the local regulations and has a safety switch for a fault current that does not exceed a value of 30 mA.
- the electrical outlet to which the machine must be plugged has a rating of 16 A and is properly grounded
- the power cord has no damage or abrasions and is in perfect condition.



CAUTION

Never connect the plug to the power supply if it is wet or if you have wet or damp hands.



CAUTION

Never pull the electrical cord to unplug unit from the electrical outlet. Instead, take the plug between forefinger and thumb and pull slowly and firmly.



CAUTION

Before putting the plug in the power outlet, make sure the main power switch of the machine is in the "Off" position.



CAUTION

If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or by qualifed personnel in an authorized technical service center.

TURNING ON AND USING THE MACHINE

After the connection to the power source, attach the cleaning accessory of choice.

Press the main switch (7). After a few minutes, the green light (5) comes on to indicate that the machine is ready for use.

Press the steam control trigger (16) on the handle to release and use steam.

Do not use the machine in wet or damp places, close to water or to showers, wash-basins, bathtubs, etc.

Do not submerge the machine or its accessories into water.





CLEANING



These instructions provide basic information on the regulation of the steam flow. These suggestions are given only as an example and intended to offer a general method of familiarization with the machine. When cleaning a surface for the first time test-clean on a small, less visible part of the surface and wait until it dries. This test is required to determine the most *compatible* steam flow and to ensure that steam will not damage the surface.



IMPORTANT

Before you begin cleaning or when re-starting your work after a pause of 2 minutes or more, release the *condensed* steam into a container or onto a cloth for about 5 seconds to drain any water off the steam nozzle.



The Manufacturer claims no responsibility for any direct or indirect damage to persons or things deriving from misuse or abuse of the machine and from not adhering to principles of basic common sense.



After use, let the brush bristles cool down before storing to prevent alteration to the bristle structure as they may become malleable from the heat.

Floor cleaning:

Join the wands 23 and attach the rectangular brush 21 fitted with a cloth (fig. 13).

Set the steam regulator to one of the following positions:

23 23 20 21 Fig. 13

- Parquet, wood, linoleum (central position)
- Low pile or shag carpeting (central position)
- Marble, fired brick or ceramic floors (maximum position)

Brush 21 must be always used together with a cloth.

CLEANING LARGE SURFACES

Recommended accessories:

26 Triangular brush



ATTENTION

Heat may deform or discolour materials. Obtain information on the appropriate cleaning treatments or, if no information is available, do a patch test on a small less visible part of the surface to be treated. Wait until the surface dries and check for any damage.

If you are unsure about anything, do not proceed.

Run the cloth evenly on the surface without pushing down on it. Repeat on heavily soiled areas. In case of ceramic floor, use the brush without cloth to remove persistent dirt. Always wipe the surface with a clean dry cloth to remove the soiled steam residue.

Wax removal from ceramic floors:

Use the brush without cloth; then wipe away the soiled steam residue with a clean dry cloth.

Other large surfaces:

Use the triangular brush 26 or the rectangular brush 21 with or without extension wand.

This set is recommended for:

- Walls tiles
- Blinds, shutters, rolling shutters.

To clean these surfaces, please refer to the instructions above.



IMPORTANT

When cleaning vertical surfaces, always remember that steam dissolves the dirt which runs downward. Therefore, it is necessary to be prepared to collect the dissolved dirt using a clean dry cloth.



IMPORTANT

With extended use or excessive pressure, the brush bristles could pierce the cloth cover and scratch the treated surface. Do not exert undue pressure and regularly check that the bristles are not poking through the cloth. Correct cleaning depends on the steam power rather than on the pressure exerted on the brush.



ATTENTION

When cleaning delicate surfaces or handpainted tiles, always mount the cloth on the brush. Always carry out a preliminary test by spraying the steam on a small less visible area of the surface and check the results once dry.

CLEANING FURNITURE

Recommended accessories:

26 Triangular brush

Always mount the cloth supplied on the triangular brush 26 and set the variable steam control to an intermediate position (minimum: for ordinary cleaning or delicate surfaces like antique, lacquered or upholstered pieces of furniture; maximum: to remove grease stains from kitchen elements or resistant plastic/laminate furniture).

Run the cloth evenly on the whole surface without pushing down on it. Repeat on heavily soiled areas. If necessary, increase the steam flow. Always, wipe the treated surface with a clean dry cloth after cleaning.

CLEANING GLASS AND WINDOWS

Recommended accessories:

25 Window cleaning tool

Fix the window cleaning tool directly on the gun handle or the wand (depending on the height to be reached), then set the steam knob to the minimum position. Spray the steam over the whole surface by keeping the nozzle at $3-4^{\circ}$. Wipe the glass using the sponge element of the cleaning tool.



During the colder months, increase the distance to $8-10^{"}$ to avoid excessive thermal changes between the colder temperature of the glass and the heat of the steam.

After steaming, run the rubber element of the cleaning tool up and down on the whole surface to remove any soiled humidity from the glass (ig. 14).



An up and down motion is fundamental to correct cleaning. It is also important to periodically wipe off the dirt collected by the rubber part with a clean cloth.



RECOMMENDED ACCESSORIES

- 32 Curved steam nozzle
- 46 Nylon small brush 1"
- 47 Bronze small brush 1"
- 48 Steel small brush 2.5"
- 49 Brush with bristles 2.5"

These accessories let you treat difficult/ hard to reach surfaces. They allow the cleaning of:

Grout between tiles or floor-tiles, skirtingboards and areas close to furniture and radiators. For these surface, use either the curved steam nozzle 32 fitted with the small brushes 46 (fig. 15-16).

Door jambs, frames, blinds, shutters, Venetian blinds. For these surfaces, in addition to the accessories above, the large brush 49 (2.5") (fig. 17) is recommended.

Non scratching surfaces (car engines and components, cast iron cooker rings, etc.). For these surfaces, in addition to the accessories above, the crevice nozzles 47 and 48 with metal bristles are recommended.

Choose the accessory which best suits the cleaning to be carried out, fit it to the curved gun and, depending on the height to be reached, add one or both wands.

Set the steam knob to a low-medium position according to the degree to which the surface is soiled and the delicacy of the surace (low=dirty or delicate surace; medium=very dirty or resistant surace).

Spray the steam on the surace and, using the steam pressure, collect the dissolved dirt in a single point, then wipe with a clean dry cloth.

Keep the nozzle 3-4" away from the surface to be treated.







During use do not touch the accessories. Before replacing them, wait some 5 minutes to let them cool down. Always keep at a safety distance of 30"from steam jet.

HINTS FOR BETTER CLEANING

As steam dissolved dirt tends to run downward, start cleaning from the top and use steam to direct the dirt to a lower point, then wipe with a clean dry cloth.

When treating points which, due to their inaccessibility, have been seldom cleaned, you must be prepared to collect a lot of dirt. For this reason, it is advisable to first use a cloth to remove most of the dirt, then a second clean cloth to wipe off any residual dirt resulting from the steaming process.

Some drops of dirt could soil the floor. To optimize the sanitizing process, we recommend cleaning the floor last. Using the jet of steam, collect the dirt in a single point, then wipe off with a clean dry cloth.



Due to their nature, scale deposits cannot be dissolved by steam. Therefore the machine is not suitable for the removal of calcium deposits.

After every pause of 2 minutes or more, remember to direct the first jet of steam towards a cloth or a bucket.

The bristles of the small brush significantly increase the cleaning effect of the nozzles, but may also scratch the treated surface. Use caution when cleaning with this accessory.

CLEANING FABRICS/UPHOLSTERY

Recommended accessories:

26 Triangular brush

Especially for this kind of cleaning, it is essential to test on a small less visible part of the surface to be treated and to check -after drying- that the surface has not been damaged.

The machine can be used for cleaning carpets and sofa or armchair upholstery. To do this job, always use the triangular brush 26 with a cloth and turn the steam knob to the low-medium position. Check often while cleaning that the brush bristles do not pierce the cotton cloth and scratch the fabric. To remove stains, cover the whole surface, but especially the stain, many times with the triangular brush fitted with cloth, paying attention not to press down too much: use steam at regular intervals of about 5 seconds; between two jets of steam, continue wiping the fabric with the brush and the cloth. Let dry and check if the stain has disappeared. If the result is not satisfactory, repeat the process.

Never clean electric household appliances.

Do not clean the machine or its components using the steam jet or *plunge them* into water. When finished using, disconnect it from the power source and clean the surface with a soft damp cloth.

Do not direct the steam at people or animals.

LOW WATER



ATTENTION

The red indicator light (8) comes on to warn there is no more water in the tank.



ATTENTION

Do not leave the boiler without water for a long time: this could result in damage to the machine.

When the red indicator light (8) comes on and an intermittent beep sounds, the tank is running out of water and steam flow will be interrupted.

Check for this SYMBOL->

Low water is also indicated by a reduction in steam jet force.

Two options:

- stop your cleaning and store the machine (see paragraph "End of use")
- or refill the boiler (see paragraph "Refilling the tank").

REFILLING THE TANK

Before refilling your APX750 Disconnect the machine from the power source. Then proceed as follows:

1) Remove the tank plug (1) by turning counter-clockwise and pour water up to the max level.

For this operation, we recommend using the filling bottle (43) provided.

2) Refit and tighten plug (1) and restart your work.

MAINTENANCE

The machine is built with extremely reliable technology and components; therefore it does not require any special maintenance.

Careful use and strict compliance with these instructions are the best way to achieve the best possible results and highlevel performance.

CLEANING THE BOILER

We recommend eliminating any scale deposits from the boiler at least twice a year as follows:

- Disconnect the machine from the power source.
- Place a container under the machine, then remove plug (X) by turning it counter-clockwise using round nose pliers or the spanner provided (fig. 18).
- Drain the boiler into the container, then refit plug (X) with the relevant washer (R).

This job must be performed after the machine has cooled down completely.



AFTER USE

Disconnect the machine from the power source before doing the following operations.

Once finished using the machine, do the following:

- store the machine in a dry place which is not subject to sudden temperature changes.
- in case of long inactivity, empty the water tank or the boiler to prevent scale sediments from building up. To do this job, unscrew the closing cap (1), turn the machine upside down and drain the water into a suitable container (bucket, basin, etc.).
- clean the machine with a soft cloth and some water; do not use any solvents or detergent.
- store the machine on a horizontal surface (on the floor, if possible).
